



## Sat It With Flowers

**Music:** None

**Content and Purpose:** Looks at the love that Jesus showed to the world when he suffered and died on the cross, in contrast to what the world tells us love is all about. A flower seller and a chocolate salesperson compete with each other to promote their product, whilst a third character (*Jesus, or just narrator*) contrasts that with what Jesus went through.

**Cast:** 3 people (1 male, 2 either) – Chocolate Salesperson, Flower Seller, Third Person

**Props:** Perhaps a bunch of flowers, and an empty box of Roses?

**Starting positions:** The three characters are standing in a line on stage. CS and FS should act like Cockney market stallholders, speaking like salesmen, and selling their wares loudly. This should contrast with the quiet, firm voice of the third person.

**FS:** Say it with flowers

**CS:** Say it with chocolates

**FS:** Flowers are so romantic

**CS:** But chocolates are so yummy

**FS:** Say it with flowers (*brings flowers out from behind back*)

**CS:** Say it with Cadbury's Roses (*brings Roses out from behind back*)

**TP:** Say it with nails

**FS:** Express the beauty of your beloved with the beauty of flowers

**CS:** Tantalise their taste buds with chocolate

**TP:** Say it with blood on your face

**FS:** Delicate, delicious fragrance

**CS:** Crumbliest, flakiest milk chocolate

**TP:** Shreds of raw flesh (*CS and FS glance at TP in annoyance*)

**FS:** Say it with violets and lilies

**CS:** Say it with a soft centre

**TP:** Say it with a spear in your side (*CS and FS look more firmly at TP*)

**FS:** Flowers in your arms

**CS:** Chocolate on your tongue

**TP:** Thorns on your head (*CS and FS stare at TP angrily*)

**FS:** (*Uncertainly*) Say it with flowers

**CS:** Say it with chocolates

**TP:** Say it with a broken body

**FS:** Say it with...flowers?

**CS:** ...Chocolates?

**TP:** A broken body, hanging on a cross, saying 'I love you'
